

THE DETAILS BEHIND THE MEDAL FOR THE 2022 DELAWARE RUNNING FESTIVAL



WILMINGTON CITYSCAPE

Wilmington is the host city where your race day journey will take place. All the buildings are different representing that no two runners are the same. There are 26 buildings. One for each mile of the full marathon.



CENTER CIRCLE

Represents the endless journey that preparing for a race takes.



13 STARS

Represents that Delaware was one of the 13 original colonies. Also the 13 miles from the start line and back to Tubman-Garrett Park. Marathoners will take a second 13-mile loop on the famed Jack Markell Trail and return to the park for the finish.



DISTANCE

Each race has its distance displayed beneath the Inspiration Coin and on the ribbon.



FIRST PLACE SINCE 1787

Represents that all of our finishers are winners. And that Delaware became the first state to ratify the Constitution of the United States.



WAVING FLAG

Represents the wish that you run like the wind on race day.

REPEATING STRIPES

Represents the repeating action needed to compete the race. Put one foot in front of the other, time and time again.





SIX SIDES

Represents The 6+ miles of the new 10K added this year for the first time.



FINISH TIME

We have provided a location on the back of the medal to insert your finish time.

INSPIRATION COIN MESSAGE

Engraved reminder to share your Inspiration Coin with someone special.



INSPIRATION COIN

A removable and magnetic Inspiration Coin that participants are encouraged share some who inspired them along their journey.



3.1mm Thick

Represents The 3+ miles of the 5K that has been an integral part of the race day experience since 2015.
